BRIEF SUMMARY: A circular aimed to provide guidance on term 2 academic classes.

**SUBJECT** 

: TERM 2 ACADEMIC CLASSES (TEACHING & LEARNING)

- 1. It is common cause that the College academic programme was disrupted by student protest and consequently the college closed earlier than scheduled by DHET academic Calendar for 2024.
- All students are notified and informed that term 2 academic programme shall commence on the 08 April 2024 except Nonesi NC(V) students who will report for classes on the 10 April 2024.
- 3. All students are informed to report for academic classes in their respective campuses respectively on the date referred above and no protests/strikes will be allowed within 500m from the College campuses.
- 4. Any student/s found to continue with protest will be deemed de-registered and NSFAS will be immediately informed to withhold any allowances due to the concerned student/s.
- The college has secured a court order to interdict any form of protest, strike and disruption of teaching and learning on all its campuses.
- 6. Students who contravene the court interdict will be arrested by SAPS and will have a criminal record registered against their names.
- 7. All outstanding assessments will be written in the week of the 08 April 2024 and students who fail to turn up for these assessments will be deemed to have de-registered herself/himself as he/she will not meet the sub-minimum for admission to the final examinations.
