RE: REINSTATEMENT OF THE 80% ATTENDANCE POLICY REQUIREMENT FOR EXAMINATION ACCESS TO TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING COLLEGE STUDENTS.

Dear Principals

The Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) sent a TVET lettered circular TC MK (Annexure A) in 2021 on the interim waiver to the examination sitting rule: 'A student shall be allowed to write the examination for every subject for which he/she attained a minimum of 80% attendance (including authorized absence and sickness) per subject.'

The waiver was a contingency measure to cater for challenges experienced during the Covid-19 pandemic.

The DHET wishes to inform all stakeholders that the 80% attendance policy has been reinstated with effect from all examination in 2023.
