IMPORTANT NOTICE TO STUDENTS

SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS INFORMATION

EZIBELANI ENGINEERING CAMPUS – IKHALA TVET COLLEGE

Results have been issued. Students are required to read this notice carefully and follow the correct process if they wish to apply for supplementary examinations.

1. Results Enquiries

All students must visit the Examination Office to:

- Enquire about their results
- Confirm whether they qualify for supplementary examinations

Students must not assume that they qualify. Eligibility must be confirmed at the Examination Office.

2. Qualifying Percentages for Supplementary Examinations

Students will only qualify for supplementary examinations if their final marks fall within the following ranges:

- Vocational Subjects: 45% – 49%
- Life Orientation and Languages: 35% – 39%
- Mathematics / Mathematical Literacy: 25% – 29%

Marks below these ranges do NOT qualify for supplementary examinations, and such subjects must be repeated.

3. Who Must Register for Supplementary Examinations

Only students who officially qualify for supplementary examinations may register.

Qualifying students are required to:

- Register for supplementary examinations
- Attend academic support sessions with tutors and lecturers

4. Supplementary Registration Dates

Registration for supplementary examinations will take place from:

14 January 2026 to 21 January 2026

Late registrations will not be accepted.

5. Supplementary Examination Dates

Supplementary examinations will be written from:

09 March 2026 to 11 March 2026

6. Supplementary Registration Process

Students must follow the steps below:

- Visit the Examination Office to confirm eligibility.
- Pay the supplementary examination registration fee.
- Payment must be made into the official college supplementary bank account as determined by DHET through our Finance department.
- Submit proof of payment to the Examination Office.
- The College will register qualifying candidates.
- Registered students will receive an examination permit.
- The permit must be presented when writing the supplementary examination.

7. Important Notes

- Registration is not automatic.
- Proof of payment is compulsory.
- Students without permits will not be allowed to write.
- Students are strongly encouraged to attend academic support sessions.

8. Conclusion

Supplementary examinations provide a second opportunity to pass. Students are advised to register on time, follow the correct procedures, and make use of academic support.



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
